Prior to the upcoming holidays, we would like to remind parents of the school's stance on illnesses. Please help keep our school healthy by following the guidelines below.

Students who are too ill to participate in all school activities should be kept at home. Please do not send your child to school with pain/fever reducers or cold medication. If they need these medicines to feel better, they are not well enough to be at school. Students may also not attend school if they have rashes, lesions, or suspected communicable diseases, without permission of a physician.

Diagnosed illnesses should be promptly reported to the Health Office. Students must be fever-free for 24 hours before returning to school. If vomiting or diarrhea is present, the child must be excluded for 24 hours from last incident.
