Who can attend Camp?

- Students entering Kindergarten to 6 in the 2026-27 school year
- Priority registration will be given to St. Bart's Students and then open to the community if space allows.

Camp hours:

- All Camps are Monday - Friday 8:00am to 5:00pm
- Vacation Bible School is Monday - Friday 9:00am to 12:00pm with before/after camp care provided by St. Bart's summer staff Monday - Friday 8:00-9:00am and 12:00-5:00pm
- No Camp the week of June 29
- Summer Camp Handbook provided to each family prior to the first day of camp.
